

Planning on breeding this coming season?

We have a great checklist to help you get started!

- Ensure stallion contract is in place and all fees are paid or credit card is on file with stallion owner.
- Ensure West Wind has all your stallion contract information (i.e. name of stallion, stallion location, phone number, fax, email).
- Ensure West Wind has the stallion location on their Import Permit (if applicable).
- Ensure your mare or stallion is vaccinated against WEE, EEE, Tetanus, West Nile, Influenza and Rhino at least **2 weeks** prior to arriving at West Wind.
- Deworm your horse **1 – 2 weeks** prior to arriving at West Wind.
- Ensure West Wind has your contact information and your horses information (i.e. registered name, date of birth, registration number (copy of registration papers is best)).
- Ensure your horse is in good breeding body condition (i.e. not too fat or too thin).
- West Wind can deworm, vaccinate and perform dental procedures while your horse is with us, however, it would be best if done well before breeding.
- Call West Wind a week before expected breeding date to ensure everything is in order.
- Ensure your horse is healthy prior to arriving at West Wind.
- Once your horse is ready to go home, prepare an area for a **1 -2 week** isolation from other horses to protect your other horses from potential disease as per the Alberta Veterinary Medical Association Equine BioSecurity Guidelines.
